Kabile, one of Bulgaria's premier traditional wedding bands, will make rare appearance in Vermont. First formed in Bulgaria in 1980, this is a part of a reunion tour of of this beloved band which last toured the US in 2012. The group specializes in performing native music on traditional instruments. Two of the group are now based in New York: featured singer Donka Koleva, and her husband Nikolay Kolev, virtuoso on the gadulka, the traditional Bulgarian fiddle with sympathetic strings. The other three band members, from Bulgaria, include: Dzhenko Adndreev on gaida, the Bulgarian bagpipe; Nikolay Doktorov on kaval, the Bulgarian end-blown flute; and Ivan Handzhiev on vocals and accordion. All of them have been regular teachers at multiple American Balkan music camps.
